Senior membership in the Wallingford Rod & Gun Club is open to all United States citizens over seventeen years of age who are sponsored by an existing senior Club member in good standing. Prospective members are invited to visit the Club at any time, preferably accompanied by their Club member sponsor. The Club offers many fine facilities for the outdoor sports enthusiast, including an 8 acre trout-stocked pond open year-round; 2 archery courses – one standard and one McKenzie course; a regulation trap field with 2 five station pads; a well maintained rifle range; a highly rated ten station sporting clay course across the pond; a dog training facility and pheasant, waterfowl, deer and turkey hunting on 500 acres of Club owned or leased property in Wallingford or one of its contiguous communities.

To become a member, one must submit to the Membership Secretary this application along with a nonrefundable \$15 application fee, plus \$1.50 Tax, total \$16.50. At that time, the application will be sequentially numbered and the applicant's name will be placed on a waiting list. During this period, the applicant may or may not be asked to appear before a Membership Committee which will review the application and make recommendations to the general membership. Upon notification of acceptance of the application by the membership, the applicant must pay the initiation fee and the first year's membership dues and assessments within 15 days of notification #1. It is the applicant's responsibility to keep the Club Membership Secretary apprised of any address or telephone number changes during the waiting period. The Club Membership Secretary will not expend a significant amount of time and effort to locate applicants who have changed addresses since submitting this application. As of June, 2005, the total first year cost of membership is \$375.10 including the nonrefundable application fee. This cost comprises: (1) the application fee of \$16.50, (2) annual dues of \$95.00 + Tax (3) annual mortgage assessment of \$205.00 + Tax, (4) annual land assessment of \$25.00 + Tax and (5) \$1.00 + Tax membership decal. The \$25.00 land assessment is levied on all new members for the first 5 years of membership after which it is dropped. Once accepted, senior members can sponsor spouses and/or children for auxiliary membership at any time. Senior members are required to work on Club projects for a minimum amount of time each year or pay an additional annual labor assessment. For the second through fifth year the annual cost for a senior member to remain in the Club is currently approximately **\$357.50 per year** assuming he/she works the required **fifteen (15) hours** on Club projects **or up to \$491.00** if he/she puts in no work hours. These dues and assessments must be paid by the October meeting. In signing and submitting this application, the applicant acknowledges that he/she has read the Club rules and bylaws and agrees to abide by them if accepted into the Club. All Yearly Dues and Fees are Subject to an additional 10% for State of CT Dues Tax. This will be detailed on the club invoices. ALL PAYMENTS MUST BE CHECK OR MONEY ORDER. ONLY.
